## **First Aid**

Over the lockdown period we reviewed our first aid procedures.

**Minor bumps to the head:** This will be assessed by a First Aider in school. If the First Aider believes this is a minor bump and parents do not need to be called, you will receive a text message making you aware of the bump and the need to follow NHS guidance

We will continue to watch for any signs or symptoms which might indicate more serious injury. Your child will be monitored throughout the day and you will receive a phone call if we feel anything changes.

**Cuts and grazes:** A hypoallergenic plaster (latex free) will be used to cover the cut/graze. For children whose parents / carers have not yet given us consent we will assume this is acceptable. If you do not want a hypoallergenic plaster to be used you need to inform school.

**Inhalers:** Please ensure your child has an inhaler which can be left in school and you have signed the emergency inhaler consent form should they need to use the school's emergency inhaler. (This form was issued yesterday with your child's plan).

**Individual Health Plans:** These have been updated and sent home yesterday. Please amend where necessary and send back to school. If no amendments are necessary could you please sign and return. Amended plans will be changed and a new copy then sent out for you to sign. If you have not received a plan and feel your child should have one please speak to Ms Kendall or Miss Fowler.
